We are a cooperative gallery in Corvallis open from late October through the end of December. We strive to provide quality art and craft hand-made by local artists for the holiday season. We donate a percentage of our sales to a Corvallis area school's art program each year.

Membership Requirements

- Be accepted by our jury panel.
- Work six to eight 8-hour gallery shifts during selling season.
- Participate on one committee--showroom, promotions or operations--during the year.
- Pay a yearly start-up fee of \$200 (due by June 1) and 20% of your sales.
- Become a member of the Board of Directors once every five years.
- Attend annual meetings (mandatory meeting, wrap-up meeting), gallery opening and gallery receptions.

Teal members pay a refundable annual deposit of \$200 for start-up costs. Teal retains 20% of all sales to run the gallery for the season. At the end of the season, the deposit and a portion of the 20% are usually refunded to the members.

Members must be able to work scheduled hours in part of October and all of November and December. New members are expected to work several hours during the two to three weeks prior to opening to prepare the showroom. Living within easy driving distance of Corvallis during the winter months is important to fulfill membership duties.

Teal Standards of Quality Craftsmanship

- Work shall demonstrate the artist's individuality, imagination and skill with the chosen medium.
- Objects made from kits, molds or commercial plans/patterns are not accepted.
- Artwork must be created and manufactured by the artist.
- Generally, we choose new artists whose work complements our current members' work.
- If an artist's medium changes from the work that was originally juried, the new work needs to be juried before being offered in the gallery.

Additional Artist Information

Besides creating our artwork, Teal artists collaborate as a team to operate the gallery. We handle all administrative tasks, shopkeeping, advertising and construction.
